

City of Folsom: 2022 Community Satisfaction Survey

June 28, 2022

The City of Folsom commissioned Godbe Research to conduct a survey of local voters with the following research objectives:

- Gauge satisfaction with the overall quality of life, the City's provision of services and management of taxpayer funds;
- Assess opinion on the City's efforts to address the coronavirus crisis and future direction of the economy;
- Assess potential voter support for a sales tax measure to maintain and enhance essential City services and facilities with funding that cannot be taken by Sacramento;
- Prioritize projects and programs to be funded with the proceeds;
- Test the influence of informational and critical statements on potential voter support;
- Identify the rate and duration at which voters will support the measure;
- Identify preferred sources of information about City activities, events and issues; and
- Identify any differences in voter support due to demographic and/or voter behavioral characteristics.




### Q1. Satisfaction With the Quality of Life Likely November 2024 Voters

## Q2. Favorability Rating of How the City is Addressing COVID Situation Likely November 2024 Voters




# Q3. Opinion on Direction of Economy in 6 to 8 Months Likely November 2024 Voters





## Q4. Satisfaction With the City's Provision of Services Likely November 2024 Voters




# Q5. Satisfaction With the City's Management of Public Funds Likely November 2024 Voters

### Q6. Uninformed Support for Sales Tax Measure




To maintain and enhance essential City of Folsom services/ facilities, such as:











#### Q10. Informed Support for Sales Tax Measure




To maintain and enhance essential City of Folsom services/ facilities, such as:

### Q11. Support for Alternative ½-Cent Sales Tax Measure Sample A



Instead of a 1 cent local sales tax to maintain 9-1-1 emergency firefighter and medical response times; wildfire prevention; repair potholes and city streets; maintain neighborhood police patrols; enhance and maintain parks and trails; and maintain traffic safety programs; another alternative would be to establish a one-half cent sales tax.

### Q12. Support for Alternative 10 Year Duration Sales Tax Measure Sample B



Instead of the local sales tax to maintain 9-1-1 emergency firefighter and medical response times; wildfire prevention; repair potholes and city streets; maintain neighborhood police patrols; enhance and maintain parks and trails; and maintain traffic safety programs lasting until ended by voters, another alternative would be to end the sales tax after 10 years.
