**SUBJECT: Conditions of Approval: Tree Removal Permit Application (#22-04840)**

The City of Folsom Community Development Department (CDD) has reviewed an application for Tree Removal at **145 Black Powder Circle**. The following trees are included in the scope of the application:

Common Name	Botanical Name	DSH	Location on Property
Coast Redwood	<i>Sequoia sempervirens</i>	36"	Front Yard

The CDD has made the decision to approve the application based on the following findings:

- The proposal is in conformance with the provisions of Folsom Municipal Code (FMC) 12.16.080(B)(5) – *The tree is a protected tree, other than a native oak tree or landmark tree, in the front yard of a residential property of one-half acre or less with an existing residential structure on site, and the property owner has met the requirements for street trees consistent with the requirements of Section 12.16.150(A)(1)(c). (Ord. 1299 § 2 (part), 2020)*

The following condition(s) have been assigned to this permit:

1. The permittee shall defend, protect, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Folsom and its officials, agents and employees from any and all claims, demands, suits, causes of action, damages, costs, expenses, losses, or liability, in law or in equity, of every kind and nature whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the issuance of the Tree Permit or the permittee's work performed under the Tree Permit.

The decision on this application is subject to a 10-calendar day appeal period which commences **8/18/22** and ends **COB 8/29/22**. Any party dissatisfied with the determination on this application may file an appeal to the CDD Director.
