

Historic District Residential Permit Parking Ordinance

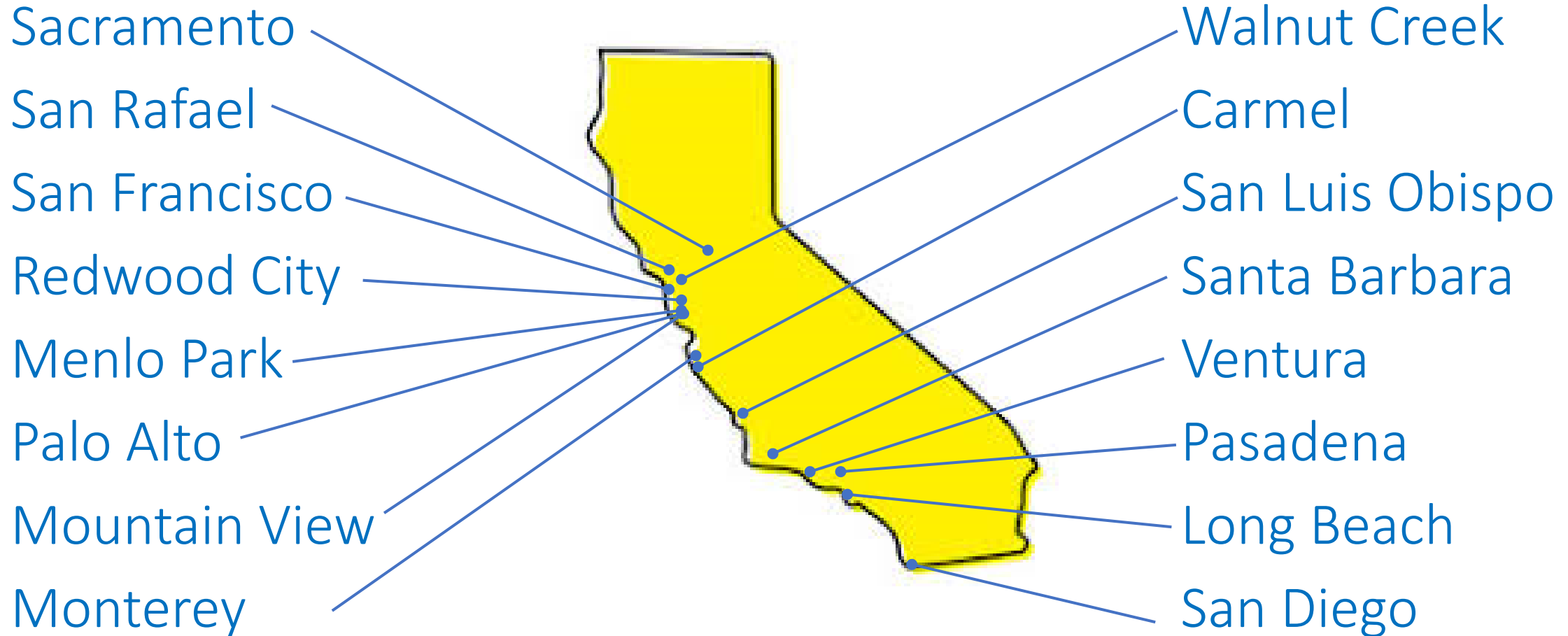
Permit Parking Ordinance

- Amends Chapter 10.20 of the Folsom Municipal Code
- Requires City Council to designate (by resolution):
 - Areas that would be subject to the permit program
 - Days/Times of parking limitation/prohibition
 - Allowable number of permits (per address or other)
 - Fees to be charged for each permit
 - Whether to allow guest permits or not, and the cost
 - Approval threshold to authorize parking restrictions

Permits per Address and Fees



City	Permits	Cost per Permit
Sacramento	1 per address	Free (\$25 replacement)
San Francisco	1 per vehicle	\$144/year
Redwood City	3 per address	Free
Menlo Park	3 per address	\$15
Palo Alto	4 per address	1 free, 3 at \$50 each
Walnut Creek	3 per address	\$20/year
Monterey	1 per vehicle	\$20
Carmel	1 per vehicle	\$25
San Luis Obispo	2 per address	\$15/year
Santa Barbara	3 per address	\$30
Ventura	3 per address	\$20
Long Beach	3 per address	\$33
San Diego	3 per address	\$9

Average permits per address: 2.5

Average permit fee: \$25

Approval Threshold

City	Cost per Permit
Palo Alto	50% +1
San Luis Obispo	60%
Mountain View	80%
Monterey	50%+1
San Rafael	67%
Menlo Park	50% +1
Walnut Creek	67%
