Bag Guidelines



Commercial Organics Recycling

When to use a bag: All food scraps and food-soiled paper products <u>must</u> <u>be bagged</u> in a clear plastic <u>or</u> compostable bag and placed in your green organics bin for service.

Accepted Bags:

Clear plastic or BPI certified compostable bags only.



BPI Compostable bag



Clear plastic bag



Correctly bagging organic waste helps keeps your cart clean and ensures this material is composted!

Not Accepted Bags:

Food scraps and food-soiled paper can never be placed in a black plastic bag.





NO black plastic bags

Black plastic or other unacceptable bags in commercial organics bins are considered contamination, and are subject to disposal fees and escalated enforcement beginning in 2022.



Bag Guidelines

Commercial Recycling



When to use a bag: NEVER! All commingled recycling and cardboard must be placed in the bin free and loose.

Accepted Recycling:







Keeping recyclables un-bagged helps the sorting process.

Not Accepted Recycling:





No bagged recyclables, materials must be free and loose

Commercial Garbage

When to use a bag: ALWAYS! Please bag all garbage and place in bin for service. Any type of plastic bag is accepted. This material goes straight to the landfill.
