

LET'S GET FOOD WASTE IN ITS PLACE!

The City of Folsom's "Green Bin Approved" organics recycling program is in full swing. All residents can add food scraps and food-soiled paper to your existing yard waste bin, now called the green bin. All food scraps and food-soiled paper must be bagged in a clear plastic or compostable bag. The green bin is now serviced weekly.

The program complies with a new California law designed to reduce greenhouse gas emission and compost organic waste.



GREEN BIN APPROVED

FOOD SCRAPS: NEW!

 Fruit and vegetable trimmings, meat and bones, eggshells, bread and pasta, dairy, uneaten leftovers, expired food

FOOD-SOILED PAPER: NEW!

 Napkins, coffee filters, tea bags, greasy pizza boxes, paper towels

YARD WASTE

 Lawn and leaf clippings, dried leaves, clean wood, dead flowers

BAG ONLY FOOD SCRAPS AND FOOD-SOILED PAPER, KEEP YARD WASTE LOOSE.





BLUE BIN APPROVED

PAPER AND CARDBOARD

 Flattened cardboard, newspaper, junk mail

ALUMINUM AND TIN

• Soda cans, soup cans

GLASS

· Jars, bottles

PLASTIC

 Water bottles, laundry detergent jugs, yogurt tubs, milk jugs

PLACE IN BLUE BIN LOOSE AND UNBAGGED.





GRAY BIN APPROVED

WRAPPERS

 Chip bags, snack and candy wrappers, plastic wrap, and overwrap

PACKAGING WASTE

 Padded envelopes, packaging peanuts, expanded foam, Styrofoam, and air pillows

HYGIENE AND PET WASTE

 Diapers, used tissues, bagged dog poop, and cat litter

OTHER HOUSEHOLD WASTE

 Plastic plates, disposable utensils, straws, lids, milk and juice cartons, bagged shredded paper, plastic bags, textiles, and clothes hangers

BAG ALL GARBAGE.



RESIDENTIAL THREE BIN SORTING GUIDE

Bag only food scraps and food-soiled paper, keep yard waste loose.
