SUBJECT: Conditional Approval Letter: Tree Removal Permit Application (#22-06613)

The City of Folsom Community Development Department (CDD) has reviewed an application for Tree Removal at **141 Pinnacle Butte Court**. The following trees are included in the scope of the application:

3	Interior Live Oak	<i>Quercus wislizeni</i>	Multi-stem (6,8)	Included bark w/ probable internal decay. Uncorrectable end weight lean.
4	Interior Live Oak	<i>Quercus wislizeni</i>	9	Poor health w/ visible decay
5	Interior Live Oak	<i>Quercus wislizeni</i>	Multi-stem (6,12)	Poor health w/ stress crack, tree failure risk

The CDD has made the decision to conditionally approve the application based on the following findings:

- The proposal is in conformance with the provisions of FMC 17.116.020(A)
- The proposal is in conformance with the provisions of FMC 12.16.080(B)(1) – *The condition of the protected tree with respect to disease, danger of falling, or long-term health of the tree is such that the tree is not likely to survive.*
- The proposal is in conformance with the provisions of FMC 12.16.080(B)(4) – *Use of the property consistent with the zoning code cannot be made unless the protected tree is removed and there are no reasonable alternative measures to allow for use of the property consistent with the zoning code.*

The following condition(s) have been assigned to this permit:

1. The permittee shall defend, protect, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Folsom and its officials, agents, and employees from any and all claims, demands, suits, causes of action, damages, costs, expenses, losses, or liability, in law or in equity, of every kind and nature whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the issuance of the Tree Permit or the permittee's work performed under the Tree Permit.

The decision on this application is subject to a 10-calendar day appeal period which commences **12-09-2022** and ends **12-19-2022**. Any party dissatisfied with the determination on this application may file an appeal to the CDD Director. Once issued, the tree removal permit is non-transferable.
