

CFD No. 23 (Folsom Ranch) Amended Improvement Area No. 6 City Council Presentation - October 24, 2023





Landowners within the Folsom Plan Area previously requested to form Community Facilities District No. 23 (Folsom Ranch) (CFD No. 23) in 2020.

CFD No. 23 includes seven separate Improvement Areas, designated as Improvement Area ("IA") No. 1 through IA No. 7.

On July 26, 2022, an amendment to the Rate and Method of Apportionment (RMA) for IA No. 6 was approved to remove the maximum facilities special tax rate for certain land uses.



Landowners requested to further amend the Rate and Method of Apportionment for IA No. 6 to remove the maximum facilities special tax rate from the remaining taxable land use category.

Proposed development within IA No. 6 includes:

- 9.19 acres of multi-family medium density
- 8.54 acres of multi-family high density
- 9.99 acres of non-residential property



Proposed maximum facilities special tax rate amendment:

There are no proposed amendments to the maximum services special tax rates.
