




Items for the November 5, 2024 Election:

- Elect 2 Councilmembers for Districts 2 and 4
- Vote on Potential Revenue Measure Submitted to Voters by the City Council



Proposed New Sales Tax



Two types of taxes:


1. General Tax

- Proceeds can be used for all general governmental purposes
- Requires majority vote to pass (50% + 1)

2. Special Tax


- Proceeds can only be used for specific purposes specified in the special tax measure
 - Requires two-thirds (2/3) vote to pass (66.7%)

Sample General Tax Measure



- Proposed new sales tax rate = 1.0% (one percent)
 (one penny for every dollar)
- Local control = 100% of proceeds remain in Folsom
- Unrestricted Council can use proceeds for all general governmental purposes
- Independent annual audit and citizen oversight



The tax revenue can be spent for "unrestricted general revenue purposes".



Sample Special Tax Measure




- Proposed new sales tax rate = 1.0% (one percent)
 (one penny for every dollar)
- Local control = 100% of proceeds remain in Folsom
- Restricted proceeds can only be used for specific purposes identified in the tax measure
- Independent annual audit and citizen oversight



Citizens Initiative



- Police and Crime Reduction to maintain and improve police services and additional staffing, equipment, and facilities
- Fire, Rescue, and Emergency Medical Services to maintain and improve fire, rescue, and emergency medical services, equipment, and facilities
- Parks, Recreation Facilities and Trails to maintain and renovate existing parks, trails, and other recreation facilities and construct incomplete parks and trails
- Traffic Mitigation and Environmental Water Quality to improve traffic congestion and safety, street maintenance, storm water maintenance
- Community Enhancement and Economic Development to invest in job creation and enhance quality of life and long-term economic viability consistent with City-adopted master plans
- Major Capital Improvement Projects to fund major improvements to City infrastructure and facilities, including transportation/traffic safety, stormwater systems, parks and recreation facilities, public safety facilities, parking facilities, libraries and large capital equipment


Citizens Oversight Committee



Purpose:

- 1. Review projected revenue
- 2. Review independent audit of special purpose accounts
- 3. Make findings to City Council regarding previous expenditures
- 4. Recommend future expenditures to the City Council

Citizens Oversight Committee



- Composition: 5 members (one from each Council District)
- Qualification: Resident and registered voter in Folsom (except City of Folsom employees and elected or appointed public officials)
- Appointment: each selected, appointed, or removed by their appointing Councilmember

Term: 4 years


Proposed New Sales Tax



Staff seeks City Council direction:

- 1. Prepare a Resolution for the Council to submit a General Sales Tax Measure to the voters; or
- 2. Prepare a Resolution for the Council to submit a Special Sales Tax Measure to the voters; or
- 3. Submit NO revenue measure to the voters
