

### **BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR**

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- 1. Sharon Kindel spoke about the importance of the Committee and Council decisions and how they will impact the river corridor, and then said that there needs to be more time and focus on this project so that all citizens have a chance to share their ideas on the website/interactive map.
  - a. The Committee decided to extend the Mapping Activity/Questionnaire deadline by an additional two weeks, to be available through Wednesday, January 31. There was also discussion about an extra push for engagement on social media by committee members.
- 2. Will Kempton spoke about community outreach missing the demographic of young people and disabled community in Folsom and wanted to consider how to get engagement from these group for this project.

  - Challenges with parking/traffic for the nearby residential areas if there were more people accessing this area and entering through Folsom Blvd.
  - Suggested a walkable promenade connection over Folsom Blvd to make it more inviting to bring people across from the Historic District
  - Suggested improved trails around the edge of property to bring people in and provide access through the area.
  - Suggested each section to be surrounded by green space/trails or boardwalk.
  - State Parks reaffirmed its conservation role and priority for administration of the Lake Natoma area.
