The Willow Creek Riparian Grove

(Resolution 5910, March 9, 1999)



This riparian grove contains several hundred trees and is composed primarily of cottonwoods (*Populus fremontii*) and willow trees (*Salix* sp.) with occasional scattered oaks. The grove extends from Oak Avenue Parkway to East Bidwell Street and lies between Blue Ravine Road and Creekside Drive. A meandering trail traverses through the grove, allowing visitors a small glimpse into the comings and goings of the wildlife that take refuge here.
