On the first day of each session, our instructors will assess all students and place them into their appropriate level. Swim Level Passing Requirements:

Parent/Tot: Children from ages 6 months up to 3 years, accompanied by a parent. Parents will get in the water to help their child learn water adjustments, support float, kicks, and assisted entries through instruction and games.

Starfish: Our program begins at age 3, we encourage learning through play and exploration. Entering and exiting the water safely, bobs, front/back float, front/back glide, arm/leg action, and full submersion.

Seahorse: The following swimming skills need to be performed independently. Entering and exiting the water safely, 5 bobs, front/back float 10 seconds, front/ back glide, arm/leg action alternating and simultaneously.

Guppy: Jumping in the pool taking a breath and returning to the wall, unassisted back/front floats 5-10 Breaths, front/back glides with kicking, beginning to side breathing, freestyle arms/legs, leg action alternating and simultaneous, elementary backstroke arms/legs.

Goldfish: Expanding into more strokes. Swimming 15 yards of freestyle with side breathing, with a focus on proper side breathing technique, introduction of elementary backstroke, breaststroke arms/legs, dolphin/mermaid kick, and transitioning to the competitive pool.

Seal: We are developing our strokes techniques. Concentration on achieving a strong 25 yards of freestyle with proper side breathing, and elementary backstroke. Continuing to build proficiency with 15 yards of butterfly, diving skills, treading water with rotary legs, and introducing flip turns and a feet first surface dive.

Sharks: Swimming for fitness. 100 yards of freestyle, 50 yards elementary backstroke, breaststroke, backstroke, 25 yards butterfly, open turns, flip turns while swimming, circle swimming, diving, treading water, swimming with pool equipment.

Groups are led by our wonderful staff who go out ahead of the group and add directional markings to the trails and lead small groups based on their preferred walking pace (fast=3 miles/hour or average=2 miles/hour).

If you can walk or mobilize a minimum of 2 miles in one hour, we invite you to join us. With the safety of our participants in mind, please make sure you can say "yes" to the following requirements before you join us on the trails, as this program is designed for the independent, active senior.

- ✓ I can walk or mobilize a minimum of 2 miles in one hour.
- I can independently follow pre-set directional markers on the trail of the day.
- ✓ I can leave my pet at home. No dogs in our large group setting.
- I am ready and excited to meet new friends while enjoying the great outdoors on the trails.
