1. Prior to installation of any sign(s), the applicant shall first obtain any required building permit(s) for the sign(s) from the Building Division.
 2. Signage shall be installed per the stamped-approved plans.
 3. Sign Permits for Subdivision Flags and Temporary Subdivision Identification Signs are valid until the last home within the subdivision is sold, at which time the signs must be removed.
 4. Subdivision Signs must be maintained in good repair to the satisfaction of the Planning Director.
 5. Sign Permits for Join-Use Signs located within Master Planned or Specific Plan Communities for valid for five (5) years from the approval date above.
