\*Commercial projects (non-residential) based on 1) alteration projects with valuations of less than \$200,000, as determined by City's Building Division, and 2) commercial additions less than 1,000 square feet, are exempt from WMP requirements and fees.

C. Diversion Compliance Fees - \$20/ton (Fees for not meeting 65% diversion requirement)

A person can typically meet the 65% diversion requirement by recycling or reusing all of the wood, metal, sheet rock, dirt, rocks, concrete and cardboard. These materials typically make up 50% - 75% of all debris generated from a project. Please see the Contractor's Resource Guide for more details.
