- Justin Raithel, Chair of Planning Commission, provided background information about the roadway movement and the trail connections.
- Will Kempton, Chair of Parks and Recreation Commission, and self-described "honorary member of active adult community", expressing support for the bike / pedestrian trail.
- Joe Gagliardi, The Greater Folsom Partnership, expressed support for the diversity of housing.
