CITY MANAGER REPORTS:

City Manager Evert Palmer spoke about the SPCA providing animal shelter service for the City of Folsom and thanked Blue Ravine Animal Hospital for their previous service. He announced the new online service for business licenses and the Folsom Police Department's new "Know Your Limits" program.

COUNCIL COMMENTS:

Council Member Ernie Sheldon spoke about some residents letting their lawns go completely brown and suggested the city may want to talk to homeowners so we don't let them off the hook. He expressed concern about the size of the City Council agenda packets; he observed that there are at least two large projects coming before the council and asked that both items not be on the same agenda so the council members have adequate time to review the packets. Mr. Sheldon spoke about notices sent by the planning department and inquired if notices could be sent to both the owners and renters. He also inquired about loud exhaust systems on vehicles and whether or not it was legally possible to check for "modified mufflers" and windows that are tinted too dark. Finally, he encouraged everyone to be extremely careful with fireworks.

Council Member Kerri Howell encouraged everyone to attend the rodeo to see fireworks; if residents do fireworks at home, to be very fire safe. She cautioned residents about DUI driving and urged everyone to drive carefully.

Vice Mayor Steve Miklos wished the Chamber of Commerce a successful rodeo and suggested staff to be sure that the city webpage have a simple explanation of water sources/uses.

Mayor Andy Morin wished everyone a great, safe Fourth of July holiday.
