Average Height: 20' – 40' Average Canopy: 20' – 40' Shape: Round headed Leaf: Glossy, leather-like Flowers: Stinky, white plumes Fruit/Seed: Problem 1/2" bluish-black berries Bark: Light gray, small furrows with age Other Characteristics: Produces lots of seeds and most germinate and become an invasive nightmare!			
  			

Olive		Average Height: 20' – 40' Average Canopy: 05' – 30' Shape: Varies Leaf: Thick, leathery Flowers: Small, yellow/white inflorescence Fruit/Seed: 1" to 1 ½" Olive Bark: Ropey gray Other Characteristics: 20 species, several hundred varieties, may live 1000 years

Average Height: 10' – 20' Average Canopy: 6' – 15' Shape: Broad vase Leaf: Dark shiny green, smooth or fine toothed Flowers: Early spring white fragrant flowers Fruit/Seed: 1/4" Black-blue Bark: Dark knarled Other Characteristics: Can bloom all summer, new foliage is reddish
