# CITY OF FOLSOM PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION TUESDAY, AUGUST 3, 2021 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Derik Perez, Recreation Supervisor, presented on the Lembi Park Tennis/Pickleball Court Conversion. The recommendation from staff is that the Parks and Recreation Commission approve the conversion of the two existing tennis courts at Lembi Park to

eight dedicated pickleball courts with planning and funding provided by the Folsom Pickleball Club.

Director Lorraine Poggione provided an overview of the current Park Naming Policy and the justification for proposing a revision to that policy. Staff recommends that the Parks and Recreation Commission review the proposed new Park Naming Guidelines from the Ad-Hoc Park Naming Subcommittee and make appropriate recommendations to City Council.
