Ordinance No. 1317 will become effective on October 28, 2021. The purpose of this ordinance is to modify Title 16 (Subdivisions) for consistency with State Law relative to map extensions. State Law allows local jurisdictions to extend subdivision maps up to six years from the date of approval, while the Folsom Municipal Code limits the extension to three years. The proposed ordinance will bring the Folsom Municipal Code into compliance with the parameters established by State Law relative to subdivision map extensions.
