SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 1318

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FOLSOM AMENDING SECTION 10.20.510 OF THE FOLSOM MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCREASE PARKING PENALTY IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE HISTORIC DISTRICT

Ordinance No. 1318 is scheduled for adoption by the Folsom City Council on December 14, 2021 and if adopted, will become effective on January 13, 2022. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 10.20.510 (General) of the Folsom Municipal Code with respect to the parking penalty that would be assessed for each violation of Chapter 10.20 (Parking) that occurs within the portion of the Historic District bounded by, and to include Coloma Street, Leidesdorff Street, Folsom Boulevard and Natoma Street. If approved, the parking penalty for violations that occur within the defined area would be increased from twenty-five dollars to seventy-five dollars for each violation.
