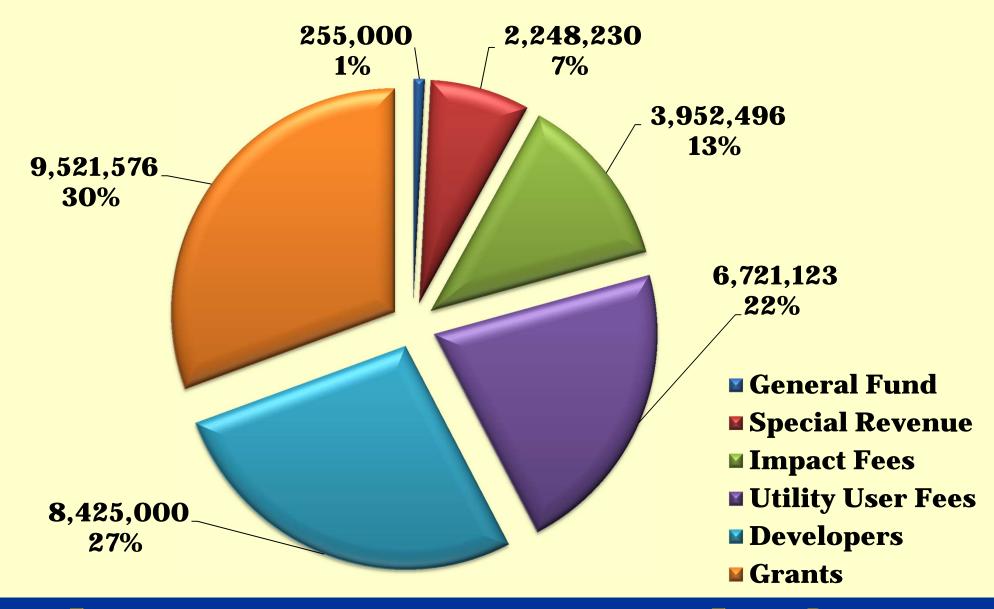

## **FUTURE ISSUES AND CONCERNS**

- 1. Increase in future capital expenses for nonutility funds will be difficult beyond only modest amounts in the next few years.
- 2. No clear financing mechanism for vehicle/ equipment replacement.
- 3. Limited financial options for major maintenance/rehabilitation efforts.
